Dr. Michael Condra is an Assistant Professor in the Departments of Psychology and Psychiatry and Director of the department of Health, Counselling and Disability Services at Queen's University in Kingston. He worked as a Psychologist in Kingston General Hospital for 10 years before joining Queen's in 1992, as Director of the Counselling Service.

As well as providing direct counselling to students, he supervises a staff of 20 counsellors and psychologists. He is also a very experienced workshop presenter on many topics, including the Assessment of Suicide Risk and Crisis-Intervention Skills and mental health (including Mental Health First Aid). He is coordinator of the university's Risk Assessment Team and consults with the university's senior administration on issues involving student behaviour, mental health and lethality.
